In The Flow

The City of Portsmouth Department of Public Utilities will soon begin replacement and rehabilitation of the existing sanitary sewer and water lines along Liverpool Street, Queen Street, Perry Street and portions of Constitution Avenue and Jamestown Avenue.

This infrastructure utility replacement project was awarded to Inner-View, Ltd. and construction will begin in September 2013. The total construction time for this project is nine months.

We hope the following information will help answer your questions about the project.


What will the construction activity be like?

Construction will consist of replacement of the existing sanitary sewer and water lines within the project area. In addition, upon completion of the project, new pavement will be installed through a majority of the project site. Because much of the work will be in the streets, you can expect some traffic delays and detours during construction. In addition, normal street parking will not be available in an area under construction. You will continue to have pedestrian access to your property throughout construction, although there may be brief blockages while work takes place directly in front of your property. In general, construction activity will be limited to Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 5pm.

Will construction impact access or service delivery?

Unfortunately, construction of this magnitude can be disruptive. However, the City and its contractor will work very hard to minimize disruptions. Mail delivery, garbage collection, bus service, etc. will continue as scheduled. Your water and sewer service will continue as normal. However, there may be brief periods when water and sewer service is turned off in order to test new lines or switch your service to the new system. You will be notified in advance when service will be interrupted.


