Nation's Largest Free, Volunteer-Run Tax Assistance and Preparation Service Returns to Portsmouth Public Library Churchland Branch

Portsmouth Public Library announces that the AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program will return to Churchland Branch this tax season. AARP Foundation Tax-Aide is a volunteer-run tax assistance and preparation service of the AARP Foundation. The program helps low to moderate-income taxpayers have more discretionary income for everyday essentials such as food and housing by providing preparation services and assistance, ensuring that they receive applicable tax credits and deductions.

AARP Foundation Tax-Aide is available FREE to taxpayers with low and moderate income, with special attention to those ages 60 and older. Tax preparation hours will be from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m., Monday through Thursday, beginning February 4th through April 15th, at the Churchland Branch Library located at 4934 High Street West.

- A sign-up sheet will be posted every day at approximately 8:30 am.

In addition to a W-2 from each employer, the following documents are important to bring with you:

- Government-issued identification
- Last year's tax return
- Social Security cards or other official documentation for yourself and all dependents
- Checkbook or pre-printed direct deposit information for your reloadable prepaid card showing routing number and direct deposit account number if you want a direct deposit of any refund(s).
