Importance of the Census

- Mandated by the U.S. Constitution
- Approximately **\$675 billion** in federal funding
 - Schools
 - Hospitals
 - Roads
 - Programs – WIC, SNAP, Medicaid, Head Start, Special Education
- Represents **\$2,000** per person for 10 years
- Ways to respond: Online, by telephone or U.S. Mail
- It's confidential!
