## PUBLIC HEARING

**22 - 07 - Public hearing on street name change and rezoning applications:**

(a) **SNC-21-03** **VICTORY VILLAGE** – Ordinance granting the request of Heather Hardiman, Vice President for Administration and Chief Financial Officer of Tidewater Community College for a permanent street name change for a one third of a mile portion of Freedom Avenue between Victory Boulevard and Elliott Avenue from its current designation to the name “TCC Drive” in recognition of the adjacent Tidewater Community College Portsmouth Campus. The Future Land Use Map of the Build One Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan designates the property as Transportation. The property is public right-of-way owned by the City of Portsmouth. Planning Commission recommends approval with conditions. (Roll Call Vote)

(b) **Z-21-07** **TRUXTUN** – Ordinance granting the request of Lloyd Wyche, of Wyche Property LLC, for a rezoning of an approximately 0.161-acre property located at 3114 Deep Creek Blvd. from Historic Residential (HR) to Historic Limited Business (HLB) to accommodate a residential development. The Future Land Use Map of the Build One Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan designates this property for Mixed Residential. The property is owned by Lloyd Wyche. Planning Commission recommends approval. (Roll Call Vote)
