DOWNTOWN - Robert C. Barclay IV, of Cooper, Spong & Davis, P.C., requests to rezone approximately 5.38 acres at 0 Effingham Street from Downtown D1 T5 sub-district to General Mixed-Use (GMU) in order to develop a self-service storage facility. The applicant is concurrently requesting a Use Permit for the self-service storage facility use (UP-20-11). The Future Land Use Map of the Build One Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan designates the property as Mixed-Use Employment. The property is owned by the Portsmouth Redevelopment and Housing Authority (PRHA). (Roll Call Vote)

DOWNTOWN - Robert C. Barclay IV, of Cooper, Spong & Davis, P.C., requests a Use Permit for a three-story 103,350 square-foot climate-controlled self-service storage facility with 793 units at 0 Effingham Street. The property is currently zoned Downtown (D1) in the T5 sub-district. The applicant is concurrently requesting a Rezoning of the property to the General Mixed-Use (GMU) zoning district (Z-20-10). The Future Land Use Map of the Build One Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan designates the property as Mixed-Use Employment. The property is owned by the Portsmouth Redevelopment and Housing Authority (PRHA). (Roll Call Vote)
