(a) Z-21-03

AIRLINE BOULEVARD COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR - Ordinance granting the request of Warren L. Holland, Jr., Manager of Wonderland Self Storage, LLC, for the rezoning of a portion of 2608 Airline Boulevard from General Mixed Use (GMU) to Light Industrial (IL) and the rezoning of a portion of 200 Cherokee Road from Multifamily Urban Residential (URM) to Light Industrial (IL). Once rezoned, portions of both parcels would be incorporated into the applicant's property at 2604 Airline Boulevard to develop a new security fence for the self-storage facility. The Generalized Future Land Use Map of the Build One Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan designates the property at 2608 Airline Boulevard as part of a Mixed Use Corridor and recommends Low to Medium Density Single-Family Residential Development for 200 Cherokee Road. Planning Commission recommends approval. (Roll Call Vote)

BRIGHTON - Resolution granting the request of Valencia Kelly, of WIN Property Management, for a Use Permit for a six unit townhouse dwelling on approximately 0.36 acres of land located at 2305 Nashville Ave., 2321 Jefferson St., and 2323 Jefferson St. in the Urban Residential (UR) zoning district. The Future Land Use Map of the Build One Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan designates this area as Single-Family Residential – High Density. The properties are owned by WIN Property Management. Planning Commission recommends approval with conditions. (Roll Call Vote)

CROSS CREEK APARTMENTS - Resolution granting the request of Community Housing Partners Corporation for a Use Permit at 2519 and 2521 Bird Lane to develop 71 apartment units and a leasing office on the combined properties. The parcel at 2519 Bird Lane contains 24 apartment units of which would be demolished. The combined properties are approximately 7.04 acres in size and will be developed at a density of 10 dwelling units per acre. The properties are further described as Tax Map 454, Parcels 2 and 5. The Generalized Future Land Use Map of the Build One Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan recommends Multifamily Residential Development for both properties. (Roll Call Vote)
