The Department of Engineering announces the following lane closures and reminders:

- The intersection of Watts Avenue and Azalea Avenue will be closed on Saturday, April 3rd, from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m. Flaggers will direct traffic during emergency road repair work of the Department of Public Works.
- The inside lane of westbound Portsmouth Boulevard, between Deep Creek Boulevard and Dahlia Street, will be closed until Monday, April 5th, from 8:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. The lane closure is during sewer connection work.
- Northbound Middle Street, between High Street and Queen Street, will be closed from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. daily until Friday, April 30th, during work by Dominion Energy.
- The intersection of Palmer Street and Des Moines Avenue will be closed on Monday, April 5th, from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m. Flaggers will direct traffic during work of the Department of Public Works.

US 58 East Midtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on Tuesday, April 6; Wednesday, April 7 and Thursday, April 8 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.

US 58 East Midtown Tunnel: Full closure in the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on Sunday, April 11 from 9 a.m. to 4 a.m. the following morning.



VA 164 West: Left lane closure on VA 164 West from London Blvd. to W. Norfolk Rd on Wednesday, April 7, Thursday, April 8 and Friday, April 9 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

HAMPTON ROADS CLOSURES ON WATER CROSSINGS, INTERSTATES AND OTHER NOTABLE DETOURS *For the week of April 4-10*

NOTE: This list covers full closures of interstates, ramps, bridges and primary roads, and lane closures at the bridge-tunnels and the Berkley, Coleman, High Rise and James River bridges.

****Scheduled closures are subject to change based on weather conditions and other factors.****

Bridges & Tunnels:

Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel, I-64:

- Alternating, single-lane closures eastbound on April 6-8 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Single-lane closure westbound on April 6-8 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Elizabeth River Tunnels (Downtown/Midtown Tunnels):

I-64, Newport News:

- Full closure of the I-64 east collector-distributor lanes near Jefferson Avenue (exit 255) on April 6-8 from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m.

I-64 Widening Segment III Project, York County:

- Single-lane closures on I-64 east and west from Route 199/Lightfoot (exit 234) to Route 199/Humelsine Parkway (exit 242) as needed April 6-8, starting as early as 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Rochambeau Drive at Bruton High School April 7-9 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Lakeshead Drive at the I-64 overpasses on April 6 from noon to 4 p.m. and April 7-9 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Fenton Mill Road west of Route 199 on April 6 from noon to 4 p.m.
- A consecutive, long-term full ramp closure and diversion on the existing Route 199 west on-ramp to I-64 west in Lightfoot continues. Westbound traffic on Route 199 follow detour signage in place directing motorists to a new temporary median crossover to access the Route 199 east on-ramp to I-64 west during the closure.
- A consecutive, long-term full ramp closure on Route 143/Merrimac Trail north to I-64 west continues. Traffic will follow detour signage in place directing motorists to the Route 143 south on-ramp to I-64 west during the closure.

I-64 Express Lanes, Norfolk:

- Full closure of the I-64 Express Lanes in both directions on:
 - April 6-7 from 8 p.m. to 3 a.m.
 - April 8 from 9:30 – 11:30 a.m.

I-64, Southside Widening, High Rise Bridge Expansion:

- Alternating, single-lane closures on I-64 in both directions between South Military Highway (exit 297) and Greenbrier Parkway (exit 289):
 - April 6-8 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - April 9 from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.
 - April 10 from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.
 - April 11 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

I-64 / I-264 Interchange Improvements Project, Norfolk/Virginia Beach:

- Single-lane closure on I-64 east at the I-264 interchange on April 6-10 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Ongoing, consecutive right shoulder closure on I-264 east at the overpass just before Witchduck Road (exit 16)
- Alternating, nighttime, single-lane closures on northbound Witchduck Road at the I-264 overpass. Click here for the full traffic alert: conta.cc/31p8HKt
- Alternating, multi-lane closures of I-264 in both directions from Newtown Road (exit 15) to Witchduck Road (exit 16) on April 6-8 from as early as 7 p.m. to as late as 5 a.m., with two or more lanes closed no earlier than 9 p.m.
- Multi-lane, progressive lane closures on I-264 in both directions beginning April 9, as well as brief, intermittent slow rolls with stoppages of up to 20 minutes in both directions of I-264. Click here for the full traffic alert: <https://conta.cc/3sNFZif>

I-95, Emporia:

- Full closure of the off ramp from I-95 north to Route 58 east (exit 11A) on April 8 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
