ELECTORAL BOARD MINUTES

The Portsmouth City Electoral Board met on Wednesday, November 3, 2021, in the Office of the General Registrar to canvass votes cast on Tuesday, November 2, 2021. Chairman William H. Watts, Sr., Vice-Chair Curtis L. Gunn, Secretary Carol Summerlyn, and General Registrar and Director of Elections Alexandra N. Reid were present. Chief Deputy Registrar April L. Barnes and Elections Management Assistant Krystal A. Artis were also in attendance as well as Mr. Curtis Maples, an authorized representative for the Republican Party of Virginia. Chairman Watts called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. The board approved the minutes for the September 15, 2021, meeting. Ms. Jacquetta P. Rogers, a voter who cast a provisional ballot at precinct 16, Cradock Middle School, on Election Day, met with the board concerning her reason for voting provisional. After speaking with Ms. Rogers, the board reviewed the statement of results and machine tapes for each voting precinct. Vice-Chair Gunn moved for the meeting to be recessed until Thursday, November 4, 2021, to allow the registrar and her staff time to research the provisional ballots cast. Secretary Summerlyn seconded the motion which carried. Chairman Watts recessed the meeting at 6:45 p.m. The board reconvened on Thursday, November 4, 2021, at 3:00 p.m., to determine the validity of the provisional ballots and ascertain the results. The same aforementioned parties were present except Ms. Rogers. The board reviewed the provisional ballots cast and agreed to recess the meeting until after the noon deadline for provisional ID ballots, cured absentee ballots, and absentee ballots postmarked on or before Tuesday, November 2, 2021. The meeting recessed at 5:05 p.m. The meeting reconvened at 1:04 p.m. on Friday, November 5, 2021. All members of the board, the general registrar and her two staff members, and Mr. Maples were in attendance. The board completed the review of the provisional ballots and ascertained the results. The chair adjourned the meeting at 2:45 p.m.


