ELECTORAL BOARD MINUTES


The Portsmouth City Electoral Board met on Wednesday, June 22, 2022, in the Office of the General Registrar. Chairman William H. Watts, Sr., Secretary Carol Summerlyn, and General Registrar and Director of Elections Alexandra N. Abell were present. Senior Deputy Registrar Krystal M. Whitson was also in attendance. The vice-chair, Mr. Curtis L. Gunn, was absent on Election Day and during the canvass because of his previously scheduled surgery. Chairman Watts called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. and opened the meeting with a prayer. The board approved the minutes of the June 15, 2022, meeting. The general registrar recommended the removal of several officers of election based on the reported performances for the Republican Party Primary Election. The board agreed with the registrar's recommendation and Secretary Summerlyn agreed to contact the individuals in writing. Likewise, due to the increased amount of late officer arrivals on election morning, the board agreed to fine officers of election \$30 for failing to report on time on Election Day. This would result in the officers losing their pay for training. The board reviewed the statement of results and machine tapes and determined the validity of the provisional ballots cast. Chairman Watts recessed the meeting at 3:01 p.m. The meeting reconvened on Friday, July 24, 2022, with the same parties in attendance. The board ascertained the final results and signed the abstract of votes.
