


Electoral Board Minutes

The Portsmouth City Electoral Board met on Wednesday, January 11, 2017, in the General Registrar's Office. Chairman William H. Watts, Sr., Vice-Chair Curtis L. Gunn, Secretary Carol Summerlyn, and General Registrar Deloris O. Short were present. Chairman Watts called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m. with a prayer. The minutes of the meeting held on November 9, 2016, were approved. Secretary Summerlyn moved to accept the minutes, and Vice-Chair Gunn seconded the motion, which carried. The General Registrar briefed the board on various items. A schedule of board meetings for 2017 was presented and accepted; a list of dates to remember for the June 13 primary as well as the November 7 general election was presented; an election day calendar for 2017 and information on the January 19 VEBA/VRAV meeting were shared with the board. Information on the VEBA's (Virginia Electoral Board Association) Annual meeting at the Homestead was shared with the board. All three board members expressed a desire to attend this year's meeting to be held March 3-5.

After much discussion, Secretary Summerlyn moved to accept the Code of Ethical Conduct for the Portsmouth City Electoral Board; Vice-Chair Gunn seconded the motion, which carried. Chairman Watts opposed the motion because of his belief that it violates Virginia's election laws. The Chair adjourned the meeting at 5:06 p.m.
