Electoral Board Minutes


The Portsmouth City Electoral Board met on Wednesday, June 14, 2017, in the general registrar's office. Chairman William H. Watts, Sr., Vice-Chair Curtis L. Gunn, Secretary Carol Summerlyn, and General Registrar/Director of Elections Deloris O. Short were present. Chairman Watts called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. with a prayer. Vice-Chair Gunn moved that the board accept the minutes of the meeting held on March 8, 2017; Secretary Summerlyn seconded the motion, which carried. Secretary Summerlyn moved that the meeting be recessed until 3:00 p.m. to give the general registrar and staff time to research the provisional ballots cast for the June 13, 2017, Dual Primary. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Gunn, which carried. The board reconvened at 3:00 p.m. and proceeded to complete the canvass of votes for the June 13, 2017, Dual Primary. Other items discussed: Due to the closing of precinct 14, Emily N. Spong Preschool, it was the consensus of the board to request that the new polling place become Brighton Elementary School which is 0.7 miles from Emily N. Spong Preschool. It was noted that Emily N. Spong Preschool will be available for use on November 7, 2017 for the general election. The general registrar will take the necessary steps to implement the change for 2018. The board went in to closed session at 3:45 p.m. pursuant to Section 2.2-3711 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia for a discussion of performance. The board reconvened in open session at 4:00 p.m. The General Registrar/Director of Elections received an exemplary evaluation. The Chair adjourned the meeting at 4:15 p.m.




