City of Portsmouth Announces New Police Chief Angela Greene

Portsmouth City Manager, Dr. L. Pettis Patton, has named **Angela M. Greene** as the city's new Police Chief. Chief Greene has served as Acting Police Chief, and will begin as Police Chief effective immediately, June 21, 2019.

Police Chief Greene has a broad law enforcement background as she moved through the ranks in the City of Richmond's Police Department. She joined the City of Portsmouth's Police Department as Assistant Police Chief in August of 2016. Chief Greene has nearly 19 years of dedicated service to public safety in a municipality.

Since Chief Greene's tenure with the City of Portsmouth, she has been instrumental in formulation of the vision and implementation of community engagement and policing programs. Chief Greene understands the importance of establishing and maintaining collaborative partnerships between public safety and the community.
