

## The City of Portsmouth Seal and Logo

### Usage Guidelines

The great seal of the City of Portsmouth is normally reserved for certificates, proclamations and official documents. When determining whether the logo or seal is appropriate for use, more often than not, the city logo is going to be the primary symbol that represents the city.

The City of Portsmouth logo is a service mark that is registered with the State Corporation Commission of Virginia, in accordance with the Virginia Trademark and Service Mark Act. Prior permission must be obtained before using this logo. Permission, if granted, is for one-time use only for the intended purpose, and, it is only to be used by the entity granted the permission. **Redistribution, graphic manipulation and/or embellishment are prohibited.** Full compliance and consistent use with regard to the guidelines are expected to promote the services, goals and programs of the City of Portsmouth.
