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

### ELECTORAL BOARD MINUTES

The Portsmouth City Electoral Board met on Wednesday, June 24, 2020, in the General Registrar's Office. Chairman William H. Watts, Sr., Vice-Chair Curtis L. Gunn, Secretary Carol Summerlyn and General Registrar Deloris O. Short were present. Chairman Watts called the meeting to order at 3 pm., Vice Chair- Gunn offered a prayer. The minutes of the March 4, 2020, meeting were approved. The provisional meeting and the canvass of votes for the June 23, 2020, Republican Party Primary were reviewed. There was one provisional ID ballot. The board went in to closed session to discuss a personnel matter at 3:30 pm. The board reconvened at 3:45 pm. Secretary Summerlyn moved that the following precincts be relocated effective immediately. Fairview Heights Baptist Church to Victory Elementary School, Saint Andrew's United Methodist Church to Woodrow Wilson High School and Pinecrest Baptist Church to Olive Branch Preschool Center. Vice-Chair Gunn seconded the motion, which carried. Chairman Watts voted against the motion. The board recessed the meeting at 4 pm. The board reconvened on Friday, June 26, 2020, at 3:30 pm. The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Gunn. Vice Chair Gunn, Secretary Summerlyn and General Registrar Short were present. No additional ID provisional votes were counted. The board completed the canvass and ascertained the results. The Chair adjourned the meeting at 3:45 pm.
