



Lane Closures During Work on Saturday and Sunday

The Department of Engineering has announced that during scheduled work by Dominion, there will be frequent closures on the following roads on Saturday, January 9th, and Sunday, January 10th, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. These closures will last for up to 15 minutes at a time.

- Wyatt Drive between Sunnyside Avenue and Virginia International Gateway
- Wild Duck Lane between Virginia International Gateway and Coast Guard Boulevard

US 58 East Midtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on Sunday, January 10 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

US 58 West Midtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Midtown Tunnel westbound on Sunday, January 10 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

US 58 East Midtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on Sunday, January 10; Monday, January 11; Tuesday, January 12; Wednesday, January 13 and Thursday, January 14 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.



I-264 East Downtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Downtown Tunnel eastbound on Sunday, January 10 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

I-264 West Downtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Downtown Tunnel westbound on Sunday, January 10 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

I-264 West Downtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Downtown Tunnel westbound on Wednesday, January 13 and Thursday, January 14 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.



I-264 East: Left lane closure on I-264 East between Frederick Blvd. and Effingham St. on Sunday, January 10 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

I-264 West: Left lane closure on I-264 West between Effingham St. and Frederick Blvd. on Sunday, January 10 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.



US 58 East: Left lane closure on US 58 East from London Blvd. to a half-mile before the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on Sunday, January 10 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

US 58 West: Left lane closure on US 58 West from a half-mile after the Midtown Tunnel westbound to London Blvd. on Sunday, January 10 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. -

HAMPTON ROADS CLOSURES ON WATER CROSSINGS, INTERSTATES AND OTHER NOTABLE DETOURS *For the week of Jan. 10-16*

NOTE: This list covers full closures of interstates, ramps, bridges and primary roads, and lane closures at the bridge-tunnels and the Berkley, Coleman, High Rise and James River bridges.

****Scheduled closures are subject to change based on weather conditions and other factors.****

Bridges & Tunnels:

Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel, I-64:

- Alternating, single-lane closures westbound on Jan. 11-14 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel, I-664:

- Single-lane closures southbound on Jan. 11-15 starting as early as 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Elizabeth River Tunnels (Downtown/Midtown Tunnels):

- Go to [Elizabeth River Tunnels](#) for maintenance schedules on the Downtown Tunnel (I-264), Midtown Tunnel (U.S. 58) and MLK Expressway (Route 164).



I-64, Newport News:

- Full closure of the Route 143 (Jefferson Avenue/Merrimac Trail) on-ramp to I-64 west, located west of Yorktown Road (exit 247), Jan. 10-11 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

I-64 Widening Segment III Project, York County:

- Single-lane closures on I-64 east and west from Route 199/Lightfoot (exit 234) to Route 199/Humelsine Parkway (exit 242) as needed Jan. 10-14 starting as early as 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Rochambeau Drive west of Route 143/Camp Peary (exit 238) Jan. 11-12 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Lakeshead Drive at the I-64 overpasses Jan. 11-14 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Fenton Mill Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.:
 - between Barlow Road and Route 199/Newman Road (exit 234) Jan. 11-15
 - west of Route 199/Newman Road (exit 234) Jan. 12 and Jan. 15
- Brief, intermittent stoppages lasting up to 20 minutes each on Colonial Parkway near the I-64 overpasses Jan. 11 between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- **New Traffic Pattern:** The consecutive, long-term lane closure under traffic signal control on Colonial Parkway at the I-64 overpass to reopen to two-way traffic beginning as early as Jan. 15.
- A consecutive, long-term full ramp closure and diversion on the existing Route 199 west on-ramp to I-64 west in Lightfoot continues. Westbound traffic on Route 199 follow detour signage in place directing motorists to a new temporary median crossover to access the Route 199 east on-ramp to I-64 west during the closure.

- A consecutive, long-term full ramp closure on Route 143/Merrimac Trail north to I-64 west continues. Traffic will follow detour signage in place directing motorists to the Route 143 south on-ramp to I-64 west during the closure.

I-64 Express Lanes, Norfolk:

- Full closure of the I-64 Express Lanes in both directions on:
 - Jan. 9-10 from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.
 - Jan. 11 from 9-11:30 a.m.

I-64, Southside Widening, High Rise Bridge Expansion:

- Alternating, single-lane closures on I-64 in both directions between South Military Highway (exit 297) and Greenbrier Parkway (exit 289):
 - Jan. 11-14 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Jan. 15 from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.
 - Jan. 16 from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.
 - Jan. 17 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.



I-64 / I-264 Interchange Improvements Project, Norfolk/Virginia Beach:

- Multi-lane closures in both directions of I-264 between Newtown Road (exit 15) and Witchduck Road (exit 16) on Jan. 15 starting as early as 8 p.m., through Jan. 18 at 5 a.m., as well as additional traffic impacts, including:
 - Consecutive, single-lane and shoulder closure on I-264 east starting 8 p.m. on Jan. 15 through 5 a.m. on Jan. 18;
 - All but one lane closed on I-264 east no earlier than 11 p.m. on Jan. 16 through 7 a.m. on Jan. 17;
 - Brief, intermittent slow rolls with stoppages of up to 20 minutes in both directions of I-264, starting as early 12:01 a.m. on Jan. 17
 - **The above work was originally scheduled to occur on Jan. 8-11 and was postponed due to inclement weather.*

Other Notable Closures:

Laskin Road Widening and Bridge Replacement Project:
