

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

ELECTORAL BOARD MINUTES

The Portsmouth City Electoral Board met on Wednesday, November 4, 2020, in the General Registrar's Office. Chairman William H. Watts, Sr., Vice-Chair Curtis L. Gunn, Secretary Carol Summerlyn, and General Registrar Deloris O. Short were present. Chairman Watts called the meeting to order at 3:26 p.m., Vice Chair- Gunn offered a prayer. The minutes of the September 2, 2020, board meeting were approved. The board reviewed SOR's (Statement of Results) and machine tapes from the November 3, 2020, general and special elections. Secretary Summerlyn moved that precinct 11 be relocated from Mt. Hermon Village, 2400 Cutherell Street to Joseph E. Parker Recreation Center, located at 2430 Turnpike Road. Vice-Chair Gunn seconded the motion, which carried. Secretary Summerlyn moved that the meeting be recessed until Friday, November 6, 2020, to give the registrar and her staff time to research the provisional ballots cast in the general election held on November 3, 2020. Vice-Chair Gunn seconded the motion, which carried. The chair adjourned the meeting at 5:30 p.m. The board reconvened on Friday, November 6, 2020 at 10 a.m., to determine the validity of the provisional ballots and ascertain the results. Those present were Chairman Watts, Vice-Chair Gunn, Secretary Summerlyn, General Registrar Short, and staff members Chief Deputy Registrar Barnes and Deputy Registrar Whitson. The board completed the provisional ballot meeting and ascertained the election results for the November 3, 2020 general and special elections at 9:15 p.m. The chair adjourned the meeting at 9:30 p.m.
