ELECTORAL BOARD MINUTES

The Portsmouth City Electoral Board met on Thursday, February 4, 2021, in the General Registrar's Office. Chairman William H. Watts, Sr., Vice-Chair Curtis L. Gunn, Secretary Carol Summerlyn, and General Registrar Deloris O. Short were present. Chairman Watts called the meeting to order at 10:30am. Vice-Chair Gunn prayed. The minutes of the November 4, 2020, General and Special Elections were approved. Secretary Summerlyn moved to accept the list of Elections Officers and Alternates presented by the General Registrar for a term beginning March 1, 2021 and ending February 28, 2023. Vice-Chair Gunn seconded the motion, which carried. Vice-Chair Gunn moved that the board retain the same officers for the next year. Secretary Summerlyn seconded the motion, which carried.
